You do this for Reserve Readiness all the time, so it's a great example of where you pack, basically, a FedEx plane with technology and vaccination equipment and all kinds of things. Then you mobilize a force on site and over a weekend will have vaccinated a bunch of reservists and do their physical examinations before they get deployed.

Patty Horoho:

We did, last year, 2.9 million exams were done last year for our Reserves and our National Guard. One of the things is that they have supply chain management, they have cold chain storage. So, the ability to ensure we have not just the clinical talent, but we've got the logistical support with that and that whole kind of continuum of care is something that they do very, very well.
